**Approved IFS Activities and Criteria for availing assistance under RAD Programme**

Sl. No.	Item	Practices	Eligibility / requirements for availing financial assistance
1.	Integrated Farming System	<p>Crops (Millets/Crops/ Oilseed/ Pulses/ Vegetables/fodder) + Trees (Horticulture/ Agro Forestry) + Livestock {Milchcows/Bufaloes/small ruminants (10 animals (Sheep or Goat or Pigs) / 50 birds (Duck/ Poultry))}</p>	<p>1. <b>Mandatory Requirement:</b> Each farming family must adopt an Integrated Farming System as specified at S. No. 1.</p> <p>2. <b>Additional Activities:</b> In addition to the Integrated Farming System, the family must choose at least two activities from S. No. 2 to 5, based on: the needs of the farm household, available resources, convergence mechanisms identified</p> <p>3. Financial assistance provided will be uniform for all farmers, regardless of landholding size.</p>
2.	Fishery (Fingerlings) Units	Fisheries in ponds or Rice field.	
3.	Apiculture (Bee Keeping)	One unit per farm under plantation/ Millets/ Crops.	
4.	Silage making for increased availability of green fodder round the year	Construction of Silo Pit either below ground or above ground with provision of Chaff Cutter and Weighing Balance	
5.	Vermicompost Units/organic input Production unit, green manuring	Construction of Vermicompost units, organic input production units and green manuring.
